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Executive Summary

Welcome to this Evening Deep-Dive edition of the Master Current Affairs! As no major breaking news has emerged since our morning digest covering September 8, 2026, we are taking this opportunity to dive deeper into today's most significant developments: The full operationalization of the Western Dedicated Freight Corridor (WDFC), the massive ₹1.10 lakh crore defence procurement, and critical economic indicators including Rupee pressure and Kharif crop data. 1. National Infrastructure & Finance

Western Dedicated Freight Corridor (WDFC) Fully Operational

Prime Minister Narendra Modi dedicated three crucial sections of the WDFC, spanning **326 route km** and costing over **₹20,700 crore**, to the nation [cite: 1]. With this commissioning, the entire Dedicated Freight Corridor network is now fully operational [cite: 1]. This infrastructure significantly reduces logistics costs, enhances EXIM cargo movement, and decongests the Mumbai railway network [cite: 1].

Global Fintech Fest (GFF) 2026: The 7th edition of the GFF is being held in Mumbai (8-11 September) [cite: 1]. The theme is “*Potential to Impact: Agentic AI, Tokenisation, Quantum – Trusted, Connected, Global Systems for Inclusive Finance*” [cite: 1].



2. Deep Dive: Defence & International Relations

Massive Defence Procurement: The Defence Acquisition Council (DAC) granted Acceptance of Necessity (AoN) for capital acquisition proposals worth approximately **₹1.10 lakh crore** [cite: 1]. Crucially, almost **98%** of this procurement will be sourced from the Indian industry, reinforcing the "Make in India" initiative [cite: 1]. Key procurements include CBRN Reconnaissance Vehicles, High Mobility Vehicles, Advanced Light Helicopters, and the Sarvatra Bridge System [cite: 1].

Defence Diplomacy: Defence Minister Rajnath Singh is on an official visit to **Sri Lanka** (8-10 September 2026) to strengthen maritime and defence cooperation in the Indian Ocean Region [cite: 1].

3. Macroeconomics & Agriculture

Rupee Under Pressure: On September 8, the Indian Rupee closed weaker at **₹94.82/\$**, depreciating by 0.35% from the previous session [cite: 1]. This pressure is largely attributed to global Brent crude oil prices approaching **\$100/barrel** [cite: 1]. The RBI actively intervened in the forex market to cushion the Rupee's fall [cite: 1]. Furthermore, Indian banks face substantial FX exposure due to the **\$127 billion** raised via FCNR(B) deposits [cite: 1].

MCLR Rate Cut: HDFC Bank reduced its Marginal Cost of Funds Based Lending Rate (MCLR) by **5–10 basis points** across various tenures, bringing the overnight MCLR down to 7.90% [cite: 1].

Kharif Area Coverage: As of September 4, 2026, the total Kharif crop area coverage stood at **1086.31 lakh hectares**, a slight decrease from 1104.00 lakh hectares the previous year [cite: 1]. Notably, the area under pulses increased by 1.84 lakh ha, while rice coverage decreased by 16.37 lakh ha [cite: 1].
